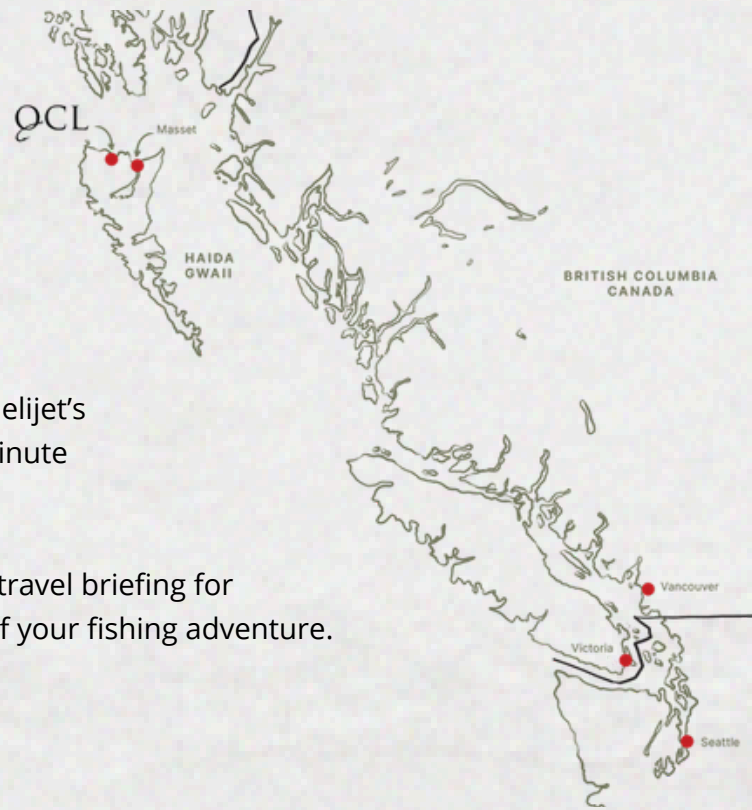


Travel arrangements for the season are complete and we will utilize two aircraft, streamlining movement of guests, luggage and freight between Masset and Vancouver (Calgary or Edmonton on select trips).

These early morning Monday and Friday departures will connect in Masset with Helijet's 12-passenger S76 helicopters for a 15-minute flight directly into the Lodge.

Guests should refer to their trip specific travel briefing for departure details, provided in advance of your fishing adventure.

EXPLORE GETTING HERE



For more than 30 years we've been welcoming our guests to remote Naden Harbour. For many, QCL has become quite a tradition and every summer we look forward to creating special memories of time well spent with friends.

The Lodge, a stunning log structure, built in 1991 of lodgepole pine from northeastern BC, is the QCL centerpiece and offers expansive views of Naden Harbour. After a great day on the water, sip a craft cocktail with friends by the crackling fireplace, take in the evening sights and sounds from the beachfront hot tub or share fish stories around the waterside fire pit.

Fish as much, or as little, as you want but either way, be sure to explore this magical place; Whether watching a pod of whales as they feed, gliding around the harbour by kayak or paddleboard, hiking within the coastal forest giants or visiting the Twin Creek Spa and fitness centre.

MAIN LODGE

The Lodge's 24 guest rooms all offer a picturesque water view of Naden Harbour, and accommodate three guests each. Choose between a Deluxe (1 Queen, 1 Twin) or Classic (3 Twin) room configuration, all rooms feature a private 3-piece West Coast contemporary ensuite.

TOTEM HOUSE

Situated at the water's edge, four generous suites occupy the top level. Each room features an inside and outside entrance, flatscreen TV with satellite channels, as well as a West Coast contemporary ensuite, richly appointed for your total comfort. Walk down the hall from your suite to the social spaces of Totem House, which include a living room, dining area, wrap around upper deck and hot tub. Take in the unobstructed views of Naden Harbour while your personal Chef and Hostess provide exclusive bar and dining services, developed to your needs.

CHARLOTTE HOUSE

Boasting a river rock fireplace, wrap around patio, hot tub and harbourside firepit the Charlotte House is the perfect, private lodging for larger groups and families. Complete with five washrooms and seven double occupancy twin bed rooms, split between two levels, this venue accommodates up to 12 guests, 15 guests with use of the neighboring Northern Room, Yatze. A personal Chef and Hostess provide exclusive bar and dining services, on select evenings to complement Main Lodge dinner service.

NORTHERN ROOMS

Found amongst the trees, between the Main Lodge and the Charlotte House, meet the Cabins – Edenshaw + Hecate. Offering tranquil views of the wilderness and, through the Spruce, glimpse of Naden Harbour. Each featuring a rainforest deck, river rock wall elements as well as a private 3-piece West Coast contemporary ensuite.

Every detail of your angling experience is carefully considered. The heart of the experience is our fleet of professionally serviced boats, each one outfitted with high-performance fishing gear designed for serious anglers.

All fishing vessels are outfitted with Islander MR3 reels paired with a 10.5' mooching rod, electric downriggers and standard mooching equipment for weighted rod fishing. A combination GPS unit and depth Sounder, VHF marine radios, Sirius satellite radios, Bluetooth capabilities and a varied set of fishing gear round out the standard features. All gear and equipment required to fish for halibut is also placed into your well supplied tackle box.

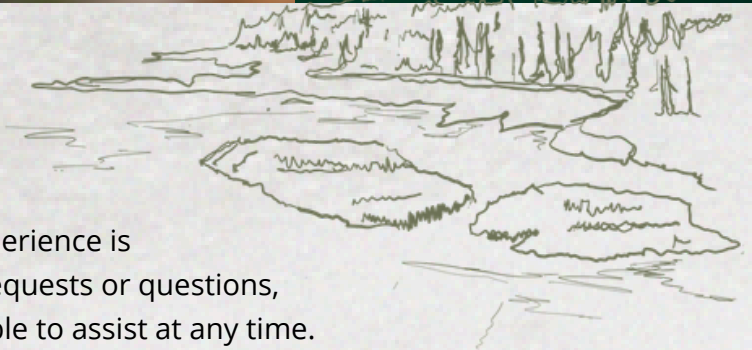
